SPEAKER DAVE RIGBY

Dave Rigby is a native of New York. He was born in Auburn, raised in Syracuse and moved to New York City when he was in high school. He attended New York Institute of technology where he majored in art. In 1975, after his divorce, Dave bought an old junk heap (nicknamed the Del Rey bomber) and drove to a new life in California. He landed a job at Mattel Toys and continued in high tech, first as an employee then as a consultant to several well-known firms.

After a 30+ year career in high tech, he retired, but in 2002, his wife, Hilda, started a business - Minuteman Press of Long Beach and, finally, Dave put his artistic talent to work as the graphic designer for the firm. It was during his stint at Minuteman Press that Dave joined Kiwanis. He was a member from 2004 through 2012 serving in various board positions for most of those years. To this day, he talks about how much he enjoyed interviewing the scholarship candidates - they were so impressive.

They sold their Minuteman Press franchise and retired (again) in September of 2021. Shortly thereafter, Dave set to work on his life-long desire to write a book. That effort culminated in his first novel, a murder mystery that takes place in his old stomping grounds of New York City. It is titled Doubling Down on Death and he is currently working on a sequel.


